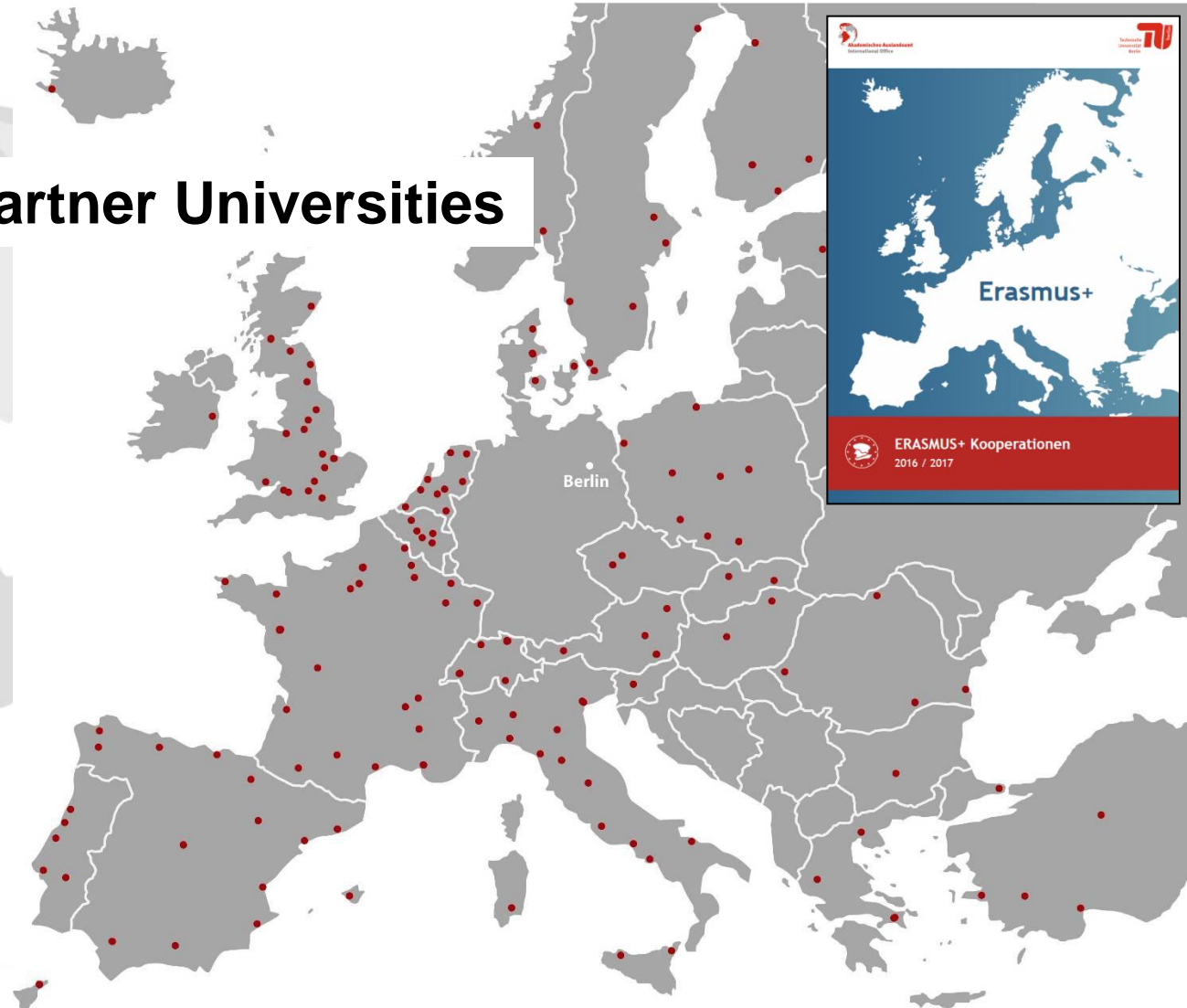

Staff Mobility for Teaching Assignment (STA)

What?

- support of guest lecturing at European partner institutions
- provide teaching content to students at partner institutions who are not able or do not wish to go abroad
- supplement the teaching offered by the partner institution

Why?

- gather international teaching experience
- learn new teaching methods
- share teaching knowledge with European colleagues
- strengthen and broaden links between departments and faculties of partner universities
- extend international network

Requirements:

- teaching responsibilities at partner institution must be at least 8h/week
- minimum visit of 2 days (excluding travel time)
- valid Erasmus+ inter-institutional agreement with partner institution
- employed at the TU Berlin
- engaged in teaching activities

Staff Mobility for Training (STT)

What?

- “knowledge sharing” with colleagues at Erasmus partner university
- individual program/schedule for stay at partner university

Why?

- professional exchange
- new academic perspectives
- strengthening of one's own skills
- expansion of international network

Requirements:

- fixed program/schedule at partner institution
- minimum visit of 2 days (excluding travel time)
- valid Erasmus+ inter-institutional agreement with partner institution
- employed at the TU Berlin

Student Mobility for Studies (SMS)

What?

- study abroad for 3 - 12 months at Erasmus partner university
- tuition waiver at partner university
- monthly scholarship

Why?

- new academic perspectives
- experience new academic environment

Requirements:

- enrolled at TU Berlin
- Learning Agreement with planned courses taken at partner university
- sufficient knowledge of teaching language (min. level B1)
- valid Erasmus+ inter-institutional agreement with partner institution
